



DUI Penalties in Tennessee

## Up to 11 months 29 days in jail, \$350-\$1000 in fines, DUI

**1St** Offense

School and/or Victim Impact Panel, and possible Ignition Interlock Device (IID). Mandatory 7 days in jail if BAC is over .20% License revocation -1 year

## Mandatory 45 days in jail with up to 11 months 29 days

2nd Offense

possible, \$600-\$3,500 in fines, and mandatory IID.

License revocation - 2 years

### Mandatory 120 days in jail with up to 11 months 29 days

3rd Offense


possible, \$1,100-\$10,000 in fines, and mandatory IID. License revocation - 3 years

### Mandatory 150 days in jail with 1 to 6 years possible, \$3,000-\$15,000 in fines, mandatory

IID, and classified as a felony. License revocation - 8 years or more

4th or 5th Offense









